**The children and leaders of the Junior, Girls' and Boys' Auxiliary welcome you as you sing the hymns you sang as a child, with drama, prayers, readings and a keepsake from each station for our children and young people present.**

**Stained glass:** Jesus in the baptistry window with the children of the world, following the 1952 fire, by artist Albert Angus Macdonald (1909 - 1986).

**Window is in memory** of Francis Bertram Wilson, OBE (1870-1956) given by King George V in 1918 - over 100 years ago. **We also celebrate the window** as witness to the **hundreds of children baptised** in the font given in memory Archbishop Thorneloe (1847-1935). The cross at the bottom of the window above sits on the font lid.

**The baptistry is found off the choir room in the bell tower.**

This window's general theme is **Christ offering Christianity** to the world. The dove is the symbol of Holy Spirit. **Below the dove is Christ holding a bowl of baptismal water** in one hand. He offers a blessing with the other. **On one side is a girl with a small baby in one arm.** On the other is a person representing **the maimed, the halt and the blind.**
